#### MAR 10, Monday DEPART CANADA / AMSTERDAM

Tour members from across Canada gather to fly to Amsterdam before connecting to South Africa.

#### MAR 11, Tuesday AMSTERDAM / CAPE TOWN

After our late arrival in Cape Town, we will be transferred directly to our hotel in vibrant Bantry Bay on the slopes of Lion's Head. **The President Hotel** (3 nights)

## MAR 12, Wednesday CAPE TOWN

Our day begins with a cable car ride to the heights of Table Mountain (weather permitting). This unique landmark rises over 1,000 metres above the city and spreads horizontally across the skyline. Following a lunch at the waterfront, enjoy some leisure time exploring.

## MAR 13, Thursday CAPE PENINSULA

Enjoy a guided walk through the Kirstenbosch National Botanical Garden, a 528-hectare natural area set on the slopes of Table Mountain with over 10,000 different native flowers and plants. Following a lunch break, we will visit the

penguin colony at Boulders Beach. Delight in the magnificent scenery as we drive to Cape Point, on the tip of the Cape of Good Hope. Cap off the day with a delightful Welcome Dinner.

## MAR 14, Friday

## STELLENBOSCH / FRANSCHHOEK / MONTAGU

This morning we depart for the long established university town of Stellenbosch, with its oak-lined streets and stately mansions. The area was first settled in 1680, and many buildings here date from the late 18th century. Continue to Grand Provence Estate for a cellar tour, wine tasting and lunch. Explore Franschhoek, situated in a beautiful valley of its own, where we shall see the Huguenot Monument before we continue to Montagu.

## MAR 15, Saturday LITTLE KAROO / OUDTSHOORN

Our journey east follows the route of the early settlers over rolling farmlands and past spectacular scenery. Our travels will take us through Barrydale into the Little Karoo. Following lunch, we continue to De Krans Estate where we will enjoy a glass of port wine. We then head to our hotel in the historic town of Oudtshoorn, made wealthy by ostrich feather trading.

#### MAR 16, Sunday OUDTSHOORN / GARDEN ROUTE

This morning we shall explore the fascinating Cango Caves followed by a visit to an ostrich farm to learn more about these fascinating birds and to enjoy a lunch featuring its eggs and very lean meat. This afternoon we descend the Outeniqua Pass and drive through the Garden Route Lakes District to the resort centre of Knysna.

## MAR 17, Monday GARDEN ROUTE

Enjoy a leisurely morning relaxing or exploring on your own (members can take a cruise on the Knysa Lagoon). Our afternoon is highlighted by a reception at Theodora Creche, hosted by the local community, followed by a visit to Birds of Eden. Enjoy a short nature walk on Robberg Nature Reserve followed by a glass of champagne. Later we will enjoy a delicious dinner at Drydock restaurant in Knysna waterfront.

## MAR 18, Tuesday PORT ELIZABETH / UMHLANGA

Departing early, we head east along the coast following the scenic route from Tsitsikamma to Port Elizabeth which is known for its sunshine and beautiful sandy beaches. From there, we fly to Durban, where we will overnight by the northern beaches.

## MAR 19, Wednesday DURBAN / ZULULAND

Relax this morning with opportunities to stroll along the beach or join an optional early morning panoramic tour of Durban. Drive through Zululand to Lake St. Lucia, an area renowned for its exceptional birdlife, where we will embark on a cruise. Continue into the land of the Zulu and our delightful country inn. **Ghost Mountain Inn** (2 nights) BLD

#### MAR 20, Thursday MKUZE GAME RESERVE

This morning we are taken on our first game drive, exploring the Mkuze Game Reserve in open 4x4 vehicles,

This evening, weather permitting, we are treated to a BBQ dinner and a presentation of Zulu war dances.

#### MAR 21, Friday SWAZILAND

Our morning drive takes us to neighbouring Eswatini, an independent kingdom. We follow the Ezulwini Valley, known as the 'Place of Heaven,' to the capital, Mbabane. Lunch will be in the Ezulwini Valley. Along the way, we will visit the Swazi Market, Swazi Candle Factory, and a craft centre.

## MAR 22, Saturday KRUGER NATIONAL PARK

Enjoy spectacular scenery as we drive over Piggs Peak and enter eastern Mpumalanga en route to Kruger National Park. Enjoy game viewing from our coach as we drive across the park. **Perry Bridge Hollow** (2 nights)

#### MAR 23, Sunday KRUGER NATIONAL PARK

Enjoy a full day game drive through the heart of Kruger National Park in open game-viewing vehicles. Keep an eye out for sightings of the "Big Five" which includes elephants, buffalos, rhinos, lions and leopards. This evening, relax in our delightful lodge.

#### MAR 24, Monday

#### **BLYDE RIVER CANYON / NELSPRUIT**

We will take a scenic driving tour from the plains of Kruger to the Highveld, following its crest for magnificent views of the Blyde River Canyon and God's Window. Enjoy the stunning scenery along the escarpment before we continue to our hotel. **Protea Nelspruit Hotel** (1 night).

### MAR 25, Tuesday PRETORIA / ROSEBANK

Today we travel to Pretoria crossing the rolling farmlands of the Highveld. Pretoria is the picturesque capital of South Africa. Explore this gracious city known for its broad avenues bordered by flowering trees and its impressive public buildings and monuments.

MAR 26, Wednesday JOHANNESBURG / SOWETO

Enjoy a morning drive through Johannesburg, a city created from the wealth of gold and diamonds, before a visit to the engaging Apartheid Museum. We enjoy a special lunch at *Chez Alina* before heading off to explore the township of Soweto, home of Bishop Desmond Tutu and Nelson Mandela.

#### MAR 27, Thursday

## SOWETO / VICTORIA FALLS, ZIMBABWE

Our flight today brings us to Victoria Falls. Discovered by David Livingstone in 1855, the falls are this region's most spectacular natural sight. Enjoy a guided walk along the falls. Weather permitting, there will also be an optional helicopter ride. At 353 feet high and over a mile wide, they are the largest in Africa. Enjoy the sights of the main falls, Devil's Cataract and Danger Point.

## MAR 28, Friday CHOBE, BOTSWANA

This morning we drive across the border and into the north of Botswana and the gateway to Chobe National Park. Home to superb game viewing, Chobe covers over 11,000 sq. kilometres and has a large variety of wildlife including large herds of buffalo and elephant plus hippos and lions. Enjoy free time to relax by the pool and appreciate a dinner under the stars accompanied by the unique sounds of Africa. **Chobe Game Lodge** (3 nights)

#### MAR 29, Saturday CHOBE

Enjoy a full day in the park with morning and afternoon excursions in open land rovers and by boat to view the game that frequent the fertile flood plains of the Zambesi. A highlight of our stay will be the visit by boat to the natural hippo pool, a short distance from the lodge.
