We will visit iconic destinations like Anchorage, Denali National Park, Fairbanks, and the Gold Rush city of Dawson. Then, enjoy several nights of pampered luxury as we cruise Glacier Bay and the Inside Passage aboard the *ms Koningsdam* on our way to Vancouver.

Highlights

McKinley Explorer: Witness Alaska's pristine wilderness from Anchorage to Denali National Park, onboard the McKinley Explorer, enjoying fabulous views from our reserved seats in the full-domed double-decker railcar. The lower level is a private dining area where we have two included meals.

Klondike Gold Tour: Visit the historic site that triggered the Klondike Gold Rush.

Riverboat Discovery in Fairbanks: Cruise the Alaskan interior aboard an authentic sternwheeler. Visit the home and kennels of a four-time Iditarod champion and witness a sled-dog demonstration, followed by a guided tour of a replica Athabascan Village.

White Pass and Yukon Railway: Descend the infamous Trail of '98 from the heights of the White Pass to Skagway.

Inside Passage Cruise: Relax onboard the gracious *ms Koningsdam* as we cruise to Glacier Bay, Ketchikan and south along the Inside Passage to Vancouver.

AUG 8, Saturday CANADA / ANCHORAGE, ALASKA

We fly North to Anchorage, Alaska's largest city where we are met and transferred to our hotel. The rest of the day is at leisure. **Anchorage Area Hotel** (1 night)

AUG 9, Sunday TRAIN TO DENALI NATIONAL PARK

Luxuriate in our private, full-dome railcar as the McKinley Explorer takes us into Denali National Park, one of America's greatest wilderness preserves. While in the park, perhaps enjoy a walk by the river, watch for different species of local birds, or raft down the Nenana River.

Denali Lodge (3 nights) BLD

AUG 10, Monday DENALI NATIONAL PARK

Today's excursion takes us deep into the park in search of big game: moose, caribou, Dall sheep and perhaps a glimpse of a grizzly bear. Watch for views of Denali, North America's highest peak towering at 20,392 feet. BLD

AUG 11, Tuesday DENALI NATIONAL PARK

Explore on your own or take optional excursions with an entire free day in Denali. Don't miss the chance to visit Denali Square and immerse yourself in the Denali experience. BD

AUG 12, Wednesday DENALI PARK / FAIRBANKS

We depart via deluxe motorcoach to Fairbanks, Alaska's "golden heart" city. In the afternoon we embark on a leisurely riverboat tour to explore the area's notable sites.

AUG 13, Thursday FAIRBANKS / DAWSON CITY, YUKON

This morning we fly to Dawson City where we will fall in love with this perfectly preserved Gold Rush city. Its wooden boardwalks, weathered banks, and saloons appear just as they did back in 1898.

AUG 14, Friday DAWSON CITY

In the morning we will have free time to explore Dawson. Consider visiting the rustic cabin of British-Canadian poet Robert Service, famously known as "The Bard of the Yukon". In the afternoon we will go on a tour to visit the historic site that sparked the Klondike Gold Rush. BD

AUG 15, Saturday DAWSON CITY / WHITEHORSE

Enjoying spectacular scenery this morning as we depart Dawson by deluxe motorcoach passing Lake Laberge, the inspiration for Robert Service's poem. On to Whitehorse, where prospectors gathered before heading out to the gold fields, now the capital of the Yukon Territory. **Sternwheeler Hotel & Conference Centre** (1 night) BLD

AUG 16, Sunday WHITEHORSE / SKAGWAY, ALASKA

Take in the sights at your leisure as we journey to Skagway before continuing our travels by coach along the Trail of '98, the torturous route followed 100 years ago, passing Emerald Lake and Carcross. At Fraser, we board the legendary White Pass and Yukon Railroad and descend through the most treacherous parts of the trail, enjoying the spectacular scenery en route to Skagway, the staging ground for the gold rush, now restored to its former glory.

AUG 17, Monday SKAGWAY

Explore this delightfully restored frontier town, complete with its boardwalk and authentic shops. BD

AUG 18, Tuesday SKAGWAY / EMBARK

Enjoy some leisure time before we say farewell to our Yukon guide and embark on the *ms Koningsdam*, our

We spend the day cruising in Glacier Bay, viewing the world's most extraordinary display of glaciers: sixteen mighty rivers of ice converge here, including Grand Pacific and Margerie, two of Alaska's most active.
